

## **Meeting the Public Sector Apprenticeship Target**

The Public Sector Apprenticeship Target, set by the government, requires public sector bodies with 250 or more staff to employ at least 2.3% of their staff as new apprentice starts over the period 1 April 2021 to 31 March 2022.

We are therefore required to:

- 1. demonstrate that we have had regard to the target i.e. we have actively considered apprenticeships, either for new recruits or as part of career development for existing staff
- 2. provide data annually (Data Publication).

## **Data Publication**

The government sets out the data to be reported. The information will be used to assess our progress towards meeting the target.
